Term 4 Learning Arrangements

As you are most likely aware announcements have been made about the return to on site learning in Term 4. The early advice is for students in Kindergarten and Year 1 to return from Monday 25 October, with Year 2 and Year 6 starting the following week. All students will return to school from 8 November. Please note these arrangements are dependent on many variables and are subject to change. We will provide advice on our local RLPS return to school plan one week prior to the proposed return date.

At this stage students will be expected to attend school from their given start date. No home learning will be provided beyond the given return to school dates. We expect to have each student learning in their class with their designated teacher from the first on-site day. It is recommended students wear masks and all staff on site will be fully vaccinated from 8 November. HEPA filters are being evaluated and they may be included in the return to school arrangements.

In Term 4 parents will not be permitted on site unless this is pre-arranged and approved as per the current restrictions. All inter school events and external excursions have been postponed until restrictions are eased.

We are looking forward to having students return and believe this will be welcomed by most families. We also understand the return to school will be challenging for many children as they transition and adjust to the school environment. It will be an anxious time for some parents who remain worried about the implications of the return to school arrangements.

When return dates are certain we will provide clear details of arrangements. We will work with the RLPS community to ensure all concerns and opportunities are voiced and considered. In the meantime please refer to the most up to date information from the Department of Education through the link below.
