








Dance and Choir Concert

- Please note the Holiday Intensive Program does not operate on Public Holidays.
- Fees must be paid in order to confirm and secure a booking.

- *First Lap vouchers can be utilised towards Term 1 Holiday Intensive fees for Week 2 and 3. (Minimum 5 day program

- Standard class rates are \$95.00 per week (\$19.00 per class)
- 1:1 Private rates are \$307.50 per week. (\$61.50 per class)
- 1:2 Semi Private rates are \$212.50 per week, per student. (\$42.50 per class, per student)

HOLIDAY INTENSIVE PROGRAM

The intensive nature of the swimming program allows for a greater opportunity for consolidation of swimming and water safety skills and assists with progression.
