Student Reports

This week student reports were sent home. Each report details the learning achieved this semester in Maths and English and areas of focus for next semester. General Comments provide insight into the way in which each student engages in learning and school life.

Teachers have unique insight into the personal characteristics that are described in the General Comment. They work with large groups of children every day and become acutely aware of individual strengths and weaknesses. For example they see which students are able to persevere with challenges, those who are able to express empathy when it matters most, those who naturally lead others and those who think in creative and imaginative ways.

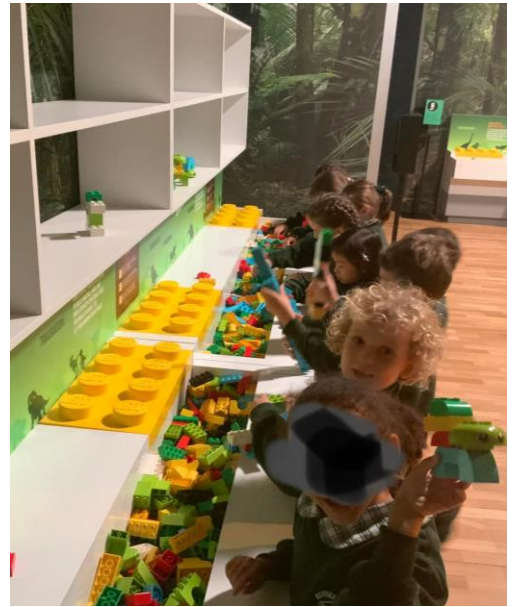
Above the General Comment on the final page of the report, tables provide a clear picture of the social and learning competencies observed in each student. These competencies are noted because they are important characteristics for successful learning and healthy wellbeing. Not all students will demonstrate these competencies all the time and it is normal for students to lack competence in some areas. They are included in the report so parents can be aware of what is observed and place themselves in a position support their child in ways that make a difference to learning outcomes and wellbeing. If your child has not been observed demonstrating one or more of these competencies, then consider whether you have observed the same at home. If so consider the contexts that these behaviours are most prevalent. What would it look like if your child got a little bit better in each area? What would be the next (small) step be? What feedback could you give along the way? How will you acknowledge progress? Working on these competencies can make a big difference to learning and wellbeing outcomes. Similarly it is important to acknowledge and give students opportunity to exercise those competencies they are highly skilled in. When students routinely have success by using their strengths they have more confidence to address areas of weakness.

The Bay Run

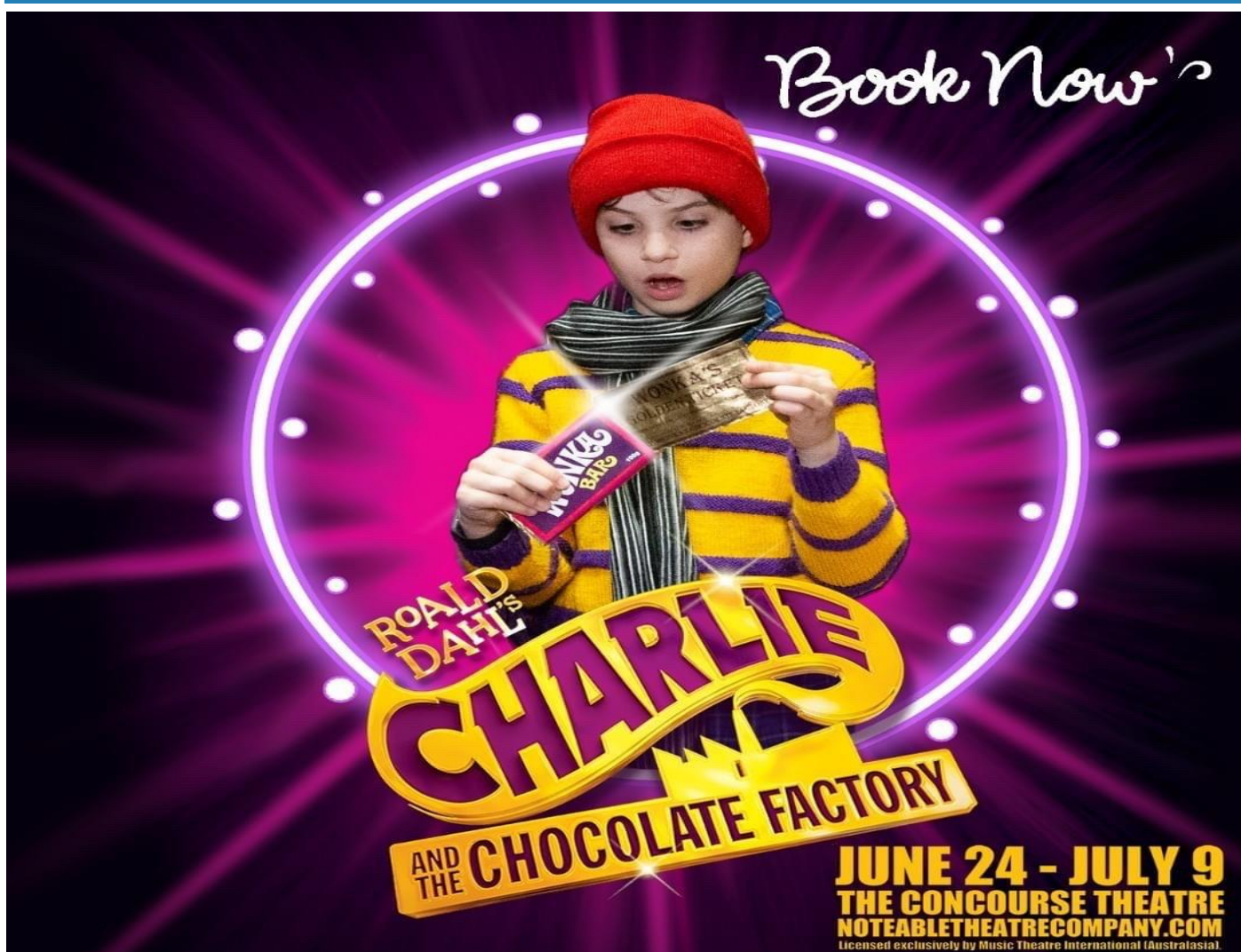

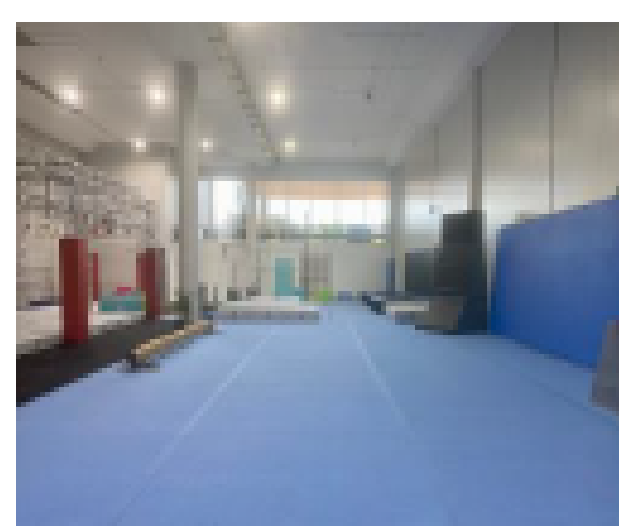

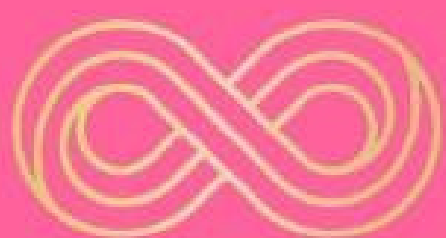
