






#### **Developing Healthy Friendships Skills**

At RLPS we use the ideas within the UR Strong Program (https://urstrong.com/) to give students the skills they need to be a good friend and to make good friend choices. Students learn what a good friendship looks and feels like, they learn how to respond when someone is not treating them well and how to manage the difficult emotions which arise. They are introduced to the concept of the Friendship Ninja. A Friendship Ninja is a person who has high level friendship skills. They are trustworthy and respectful and are able to manage difficult relationships in positive and constructive ways. Relationship skills are an important aspect of student wellbeing as difficult interactions are an inevitable part of growing. Students who are strong in this area are likely to manage challenging peers in ways which allow them to move on without negative impacts on their wellbeing. Our teachers will use the language of URStrong throughout the year and we invite you to refer to the information provided below or the website if you want to know more.





#### [Reminder] Classroom Volunteers Needed

We would once again like to invite all K-2 parents to volunteer in our classrooms.






2. Right click to download the zip file.


